## Objective(s)

- Children can learn about Chinese art and culture.
- Ability to follow the rules of outdoor visit.

## **Brief Descriptions:**

Teachers and children visited the exhibition hall and learned about Chinese art and culture - Ink Painting, which includes calligraphy and painting. The children learned that Chinese art is famous for ink painting and calligraphy, in which water and ink are used to create and write on rice paper. The content of the paintings emphasizes on the meaning and there is a small amount of white space, so that the paintings have the effect of black and white, thick and thin. The paintings can be applied to different objects, such as banners, scrolls, etc., while the calligraphy is done in different fonts, such as Regular Script, Seal Script, etc. The lines follow the thickness of the brush. The lines vary according to the thickness of the brushes and the direction of writing is divided into vertical and horizontal.

At the "Happy Birthday Likeboxes under the Sun" art installation, children were able to appreciate the design of the installation with the connotations of the Chinese characters, and realized that although the Chinese characters are complicated, they can be disassembled into simple and easy-to-remember characters. During the activity, some children were able to find hidden Chinese character patterns, such as heart and human, from the many art installations.
