BOC Mini Lunar New Year's Eve Market

Objective(s)

- Parent-child activities can increase the opportunities of parent-child fun.
- Children can experience the atmosphere of Lunar New Year and gain the experience of sharing and celebrating with others.
- Children can learn about traditional Chinese New Year customs and traditions at the Lunar New Year Fair stalls.

Brief Descriptions:

This year, the school invited a national Grade 1 shadow puppet master to visit the school. The shadow puppet show was lively and unique, attracting parents and children to watch attentively, and there was also a section for children to manipulate the shadow puppet, so that they could have initial contact with and recognize the relationship between light and shadow. A wishing tree was set up at the Lunar New Year's Eve Market. Parents could write down their wishes and hang them on the tree after completing the lantern guessing activity. Parents and children could take photos in front of the red curtains and plaques in the photo area, and the "God of Fortune" would visit different booths to give away candies and take photos of the event. As for the Lunar New Year games, they were "Dragon Drums for the New Year", "Dragon Vine for the Tigers" and "Flying Dragon in the Sky". In the "Dragon Drums" game, children who kicked the ball into the dragon's goal would receive a gift. In the "Dragon Blue Tiger Leap" game, children can use the arrow shafts for kettle throwing activities. In the "Flying Dragon in the Sky" booth, lettuce and lion dance props were made for green picking, and lion dance footprints were set on the floor so that children could step on the footprints during the lion dance to pick green. In the snack area, the food produced this time was sweetened onion cake, parents and children made the food together. In the craft area, the school provided materials for the children and their parents to make non-woven Chinese New Year bags together. At the beginning of the event, the younger class performed a New Year's song and then watched a shadow puppet show; the elder class watched a shadow puppet show and then performed a New Year's show. After that, parents and children went to different Lunar New Year's Eve booths to do activities, including: Lunar New Year's Eve booth games, snack area, graphic design area, photography area, God of Wealth and Blessing, Wishing Tree, and Guessing the Lantern Riddle activity.
