## Name of Activity

FATHER'S Day ACTIVITY – "Daddy is the best!"

#### Objective(s)

- Let young children understand the greatness of their fathers and the hard work they put in through Chinese historical stories, ancient poetry appreciation, and games.
- Through Father's Day gifts and songs, teach children to express their love for their fathers.
- Cultivate the good virtue of "filial piety" in children through discussions and roleplaying, in line with Chinese traditional values.

## **Brief Descriptions:**

Through the story "Filial Huang Xiang," children learn about Huang Xiang, a filial child who understands his father's hard work and responsibility of taking care of the family. Whenever he has free time, he helps with household chores to ease his father's burden. During the summer, he fans his father to keep him cool; in winter, he warms his father's beddings. Through these activities, children experience the filial piety and love that young Huang Xiang shows towards his father, learning to consider their father's well-being and exemplify filial piety, which is truly worth emulating. After the story, children comprehend their father's sacrifices for the family and learn to reciprocate their father's love in different ways. They discuss and share methods to show respect and love to their fathers, such as serving tea, giving small gifts, massages, expressing blessings, and share how they express love to their own fathers at home.

Additionally, in the higher classes, children recite the ancient poem "Washing Children's Poem," understanding that as a father, ensuring the child's peace, health, and happiness is already fulfilling. Through group games, children engage in role-playing, experiencing the process of Huang Xiang easing his father's burden through tasks like chores, keeping warm, and fanning.

In creating Father's Day crafts, children put great effort into making "Sweet Cups," using various materials to craft personalized cups with unique styles to give to their fathers. When fathers receive these gifts, they feel touched and appreciate their children's thoughtfulness. This activity not only achieves its intended purpose of teaching children to express love to their fathers but also strengthens the bond between children and their fathers, fostering parent-child relationships, and nurturing children's good virtues of filial piety in Chinese tradition.
