Mother's Day - "Mom, I Love You!"

Objective(s)

- Let young children understand the greatness of mothers and recognize their hard work through Chinese historical stories, reciting ancient poems, and games.
- Through Mother's Day gifts and songs, help children learn to express their love for their mothers.

Brief Descriptions:

Additionally, they simulate doing household chores as the mother, feeling, and appreciating her meticulous care, understanding her selfless dedication and hard work. Children create a "Happy Baby Box" gift using various materials, designing, and drawing patterns on the box themselves. They then string sparkling beads onto a unique and exquisite bracelet using a rope, as a small gift for their mothers, expressing their heartfelt appreciation. Furthermore, in the "Respecting and Loving Mothers" theatre, teachers and children discuss ways to show respect and express gratitude to mothers, such as serving tea or helping with household chores, helping children understand the greatness of mothers, appreciating their hardships and selfless love.

In conclusion, these activities promote the emotional bond between children and mothers, while teaching them ways to express love and gratitude to their mothers, demonstrating the virtues of filial piety in Chinese tradition.
