Objective(s)

- A preliminary understanding of artifacts from past dynasties.
- In the 'Children's Discovery Gallery,' young children are allowed to discover the wonders of nature, uncover the mysteries of archaeology, and experience the sentiments of Hong Kong in bygone days.

Brief Descriptions:

The teacher leads the children on a tour of the 'Xu Zhan Tang Chinese Art Gallery,' where, through guided introductions, they learn to appreciate the exhibits of Chinese artifacts and gain an initial understanding of cultural relics such as ceramics, pottery sculptures, and bronzeware from past dynasties, developing a preliminary knowledge of Chinese culture and art. Inside the 'Children's Discovery Gallery,' children simulate walking through the Mai Po Marshes, delve underground, and dive underwater; they also make friends with birds, insects, and marine life. Children experience the work of local archaeologists through interactive manipulation and get a glimpse of Hong Kong's mysterious unearthed relics; moreover, they explore traditional village life in the New Territories and have hands-on encounters with toys from children in days past. Through this visitation activity, children can recognize national art treasures and cultivate a sense of belonging to their country. From what we observe, by immersing themselves in nature, children learn to take care of public property, respect other visitors and maintain order – all marks of good citizenship
