Hong Kong Heritage Museum Study Day

Objective(s)

- In the exhibition hall of "Looking for her in the crowd", learn about ancient Chinese female cultural relics, and initially establish a concept of the life of ancient Chinese characters.
- In the "Children's Discovery Center", let children discover the wonders of nature, uncover the mysteries of archaeology and experience the feelings of Hong Kong in the past.

Brief Descriptions:

On the morning of the event, the teacher first browsed the website of the "Hong Kong Heritage Museum" with the children, so that the children had a preliminary idea of the venue and content of the visit.

The teacher led the children into the "Looking for Her in the Crowd" exhibition hall. Through admiring the cultural relics exhibits, the children learned about the daily life of women with surnames in ancient China. For example: their clothes, jewellery, makeup, daily necessities and recreational activities, etc.

The "Children's Discovery Pavilion" exhibition hall is divided into 8 learning and game areas, allowing children to walk in the Mai Po swamp area, go deep into the ground, dive into the water; and make friends with birds, insects and marine life. Children also experience the work of local archaeologists and see the mysterious unearthed cultural relics in Hong Kong through manipulation. In addition, children explore the life of traditional villages in the New Territories and get in touch with children's gadgets in the

past. The environment and equipment of the "Children's Discovery Center" demonstrate active learning and curiosity. Through various interactive facilities, children can discover the wonders of nature, uncover the mysteries of archaeology, and experience Hong Kong's past.

Through this visit, children can learn about the country and Chinese culture and develop a sense of belonging to the country. From the observation, the children can take good care of public property, respect other visitors and observe order, and they are good citizens.

On the whole, the children were engaged, happy and cooperative when visiting the activities. Browsing the relevant webpages with the children before the activity can also help to deepen the children's concept of the content of the visit and make it easier to understand the relevant information.
