A Trip to Hong Kong Palace Museum

Objective(s)

- To inspire children to explore the connection between art and life through precious artifacts.
- To enhance interest in cultural arts and to foster children's appreciation and ability to enjoy cultural arts.
- To encourage children to study and appreciate Chinese art and culture.

Brief Descriptions:

Teachers guided the children to walk through and explore the rooms with various exhibitions, including renowned artifacts from the Palace Museum, ceramics from the Neolithic period to the Yuan dynasty, and imperial porcelain from the Ming and Qing dynasties. Teachers introduced the names of ceramics, encouraging children to observe patterns, shapes, and colors while discussing their uses and features. They also learned about the background and cultural significance of each piece.

Children admired Qing dynasty portraits, with teachers explaining the historical importance of the figures depicted and prompting discussions about details such as clothing, colors, and expressions. They gained insight into Chinese culture and life during that era. Additionally, they explored a model of the Forbidden City, learning its history and architectural features.

After the visit, teachers invited children to share their experiences from the Palace Museum and describe their favorite artworks. Also, they created their own craft pieces with accompanying descriptions and showcased their works.
