Yummy Yummy Dim Sum Day

Objective(s)

- To Learn about the Chinese culinary culture unique decor and ambiance of traditional tea houses.
- To discover the names of various dim sum dishes, Chinese teas, and traditional tea sets.
- To experience the joy of visiting a tea house and savoring delicious dim sum.

Brief Descriptions:

On the event day, teachers took the children to a tea house on Man Nien Street in Sai Kung. They began by washing their teacups and utensils, then learned the art of tea brewing, exploring the tools and etiquette involved. The children tasted various teas, discovering different flavors and types of Chinese tea too.

Next, they used dim sum order slips to select dishes collaboratively, learning the ordering process and the names of items like shrimp dumplings, siu mai, and char siu buns. They practiced tea house etiquette, such as thanking others when tea is poured and keeping the dining area clean.

After returning to school, children recorded their experiences with parent-child activity sheets and shared their favorite dim sum. They also created dim sum models with clay for role-playing in a simulated tea house corner.
