**Experiential Learning Activity: Serving Chinese Tea**

**Objective(s)**

- Children learn to make tea, pour tea, and offer tea through hands-on experience, thereby gaining an understanding of Chinese tea culture.
- Enhance children's autonomy and proactivity in daily life. They learn to take responsibility, and thanks for their family's care.
- Children learn to appreciate the hard work of their family members, express respect, gratitude, and care towards elders, thereby cultivating the traditional virtue of "filial piety and gratitude" in children.

**Brief Descriptions:**

- Activities for young children to experience clay creation, using different techniques to make a 'teacup', thereby getting to know one of China's long-standing traditional crafts.
- Children explore tea leaves and tea powder grinding in the life experience area, and make flower tea bags to give to their family members to express gratitude.
- Children learn to pick the tea, as well as brewing, pouring, and serving tea, to understand Chinese tea culture, in order to help children appreciate their family's hard work and show respect for their elders.
