Springtime: Little Farmers of China

Objective(s)

- (1) Understand that spring is the season for plant growth.
- (2) Gain a basic understanding of farmers and planting work in Chinese culture.
- (3) Cultivate children's appreciation for plants and the values of diligence found in Chinese culture.

Brief Descriptions:

With demonstration and guidance from teachers, children actively participated in storytelling, learning about farmers' planting work, and understanding that plants need soil, water, and sunlight to grow. During the planting experience, they showed strong interest and were able to follow instructions to complete simple steps such as digging soil, sowing seeds, and watering.

Classroom activity corners further extended their learning, allowing children to explore the uses and value of plants from different perspectives. In the exploration area, children showed initiative in observing and comparing different seeds. In the life experience and snack preparation areas, they made flower tea and fruit snacks, experiencing the process from planting to harvesting and learning to value the results.

Overall, the activity not only supported children's development in cognition, language, and practical skills, but also successfully nurtured positive attitudes such as caring for plants, respecting labour, and valuing hard work.
