"Get Close to Chinese Honeybees" Workshop

Objective(s)

- 1) Through hands-on experiential activities, enable children to learn about the characteristics of bees and acquire related knowledge about them.
- 2) Through interactive group activities, help children learn the spirit of cooperation and unity from the social habits of bees.

Brief Descriptions:

To start, one of our teachers will introduce the Chinese honeybee conservationist to the children. The conservationist will then use a slideshow to teach the children all about bees—their appearance, where they live, who makes up their family, and how they grow from egg to adult. A short video will also show how conservationists and beekeepers help move beehives found in the city back to the wild, and the children will learn how to behave around bees and what they can do to help protect them. After that, the children will be split into two groups and take turns taking part in two activities. One group will get to observe a real beehive in a display case and watch the bees moving around up close, while the other group will have a chance to dress up in beekeeper gear and take photos to remember the experience.
