Experiential Learning Week: Hamster Paradise

Objective(s)

- Through activities, children get to know the physical characteristics and living habits of hamsters, helping them understand the basic needs of small animals and develop a sense of responsibility in pet care.
- By using different materials and tools to build a 'Hamster Paradise,' children learn about hamster living habits, housing needs and basic care during the collaborative creation process, while also picking up basic spatial arrangement and problem-solving skills.
- Activities link to Chinese cultural values such as 'respecting life, showing kindness to creatures, and caring for animals,' helping children cultivate compassion for animals, cherish life, and develop a positive attitude toward life.

Brief Descriptions:

- A hamster habitat is set up in the nature corner, complete with hamsters and related supplies like exercise wheels, small houses, water bottles, and wood shavings, allowing children to observe their daily habits and behaviors.
- Children continuously build, test, and adjust the 'Hamster Paradise,' learning about animal needs, with the hamsters eventually moving in for observation and reflection. During the activities, children discuss, divide tasks, and collaborate, developing language skills, social abilities and a sense of responsibility.
- Children create short videos and share them, expressing their learning experiences and promoting messages about caring for animals.
