**Colorful FUN Day of Chinese New Year** 

# Objective(s)

- Feel the festive atmosphere of the Chinese New Year.
- Learn about the customs and culture of the Chinese New Year.
- Promote parent-child relationships and interactions.
- Understand that the New Year is one of the traditional festivals in Chinese culture.

# **Brief Descriptions:**

Before the event, the teacher introduced different Chinese New Year foods to the children. Afterwards, the teacher invited the children to help set up booths for the Colorful Day of Chinese New Year, preparing for the event. The activities and booths were as follows:

### Booth 1: A Throw of a Fortune

The teacher placed five pots on the ground and asked the children to throw arrows into one of the pots, saying a congratulatory phrase, such as "Wishing you good health."

#### Booth 2: Like Fish in Water

The teacher asked the children to use a fishing net to catch three goldfish from a pond and to say three congratulatory phrases from the cards to their parents. The teacher or staff assisted in placing the goldfish into bags and adding air.

#### **Booth 3: Wish Tree**

Parents and children could go to the table in front of the wish tree to receive a treasure plate from the teacher, which included a handmade orange picture and a wish board. After writing congratulatory phrases on the wish board, they could connect the orange and the wish board and toss them in front of the wish tree.

**Booth 4: Sugar Painting and Me** 

Parents and children could exchange for a piece of sugar painting at the booth, where they could appreciate the master creating sugar paintings.

Booth 5: My Appointment with Dragon's Beard Candy

Parents and children could exchange for a piece of dragon's beard candy at the booth, where the children could appreciate the master making the candy.

**Booth 6: Lifelong Beauty** 

Parents and children waited at the designated time for face painting at the Lifelong Beauty booth. They could choose different patterns, and then a face painter helped create beautiful designs on the children's faces or hands.

Booth 7: Little Artists of the Year of the Dragon

Parents and children made small crafts together for the New Year.

Booth8: Calligraphers of the Year of the Dragon

Parents and children became calligraphers together, writing congratulatory phrases on gold paper.
